# Treats galore for children

SINGERS from the Sister2Sister School of Singing are helping hearing impaired children through music.

They are supporting Breakfast with Santa, the Hear the Children Early Intervention Centre's fund-raising event at the Castle Hill RSL on December 11 at 10am.

The Castle Hill-based school is providing two sets of entertainment with a 10-minute set to open the show, with an appearance by Towers Ted, and will close with a 20-minute Christmas carols set and share the stage with Santa.

Co-owners and sisters Christine and Sharon Muscat are also giving away vocal

assessment vouchers to be raffled and a 10 per cent discount voucher for each child.

Christine said her students were excited to get on stage and be part of the show.

"Events like this make people happy and we can't wait to do it," she said. "We like to help the community as much as possible, especially when kids are involved."

There will also be a 45-minute *The Jitterbugs Christmas Spectacular* show, a magic show by Stretch the Magic Clown and balloon artist clowns.
